

Sowing Seeds of Social Beauty

One Page Summary

We, the general public, can choose to accept and continue an economic model that predictably generates **Mean Arrangements of Man** and **Social Atrocities**, or we can choose a new economic model that generates **Kind Social Arrangements** and **Social Beauty**.

Sowing Seeds of Social Beauty recommends the latter. The manuscript offers the Children's Hospital Public Economy Model (CHPEM) as an alternative to global corporate capitalism. The CHPEM has been successfully practiced for decades by pediatricians, internationally; has generated kind social arrangements and great Social Beauty within children's hospitals; and could be applied to the general economy of nations.

As explained in this manuscript, the CHPEM is foundationally based on a set of social understandings that is completely different from and more wholesome and accurate than the set of negative and demoralizing social understandings upon which global corporate capitalism is based and upon whose acceptance corporate capitalism depends. The manuscript tells the untold story of the CHPEM, explains how it could be applied to the general economy, describes what societies might look like if it were applied, and addresses anticipated fears and concerns about application of the CHPEM to the general economy.

The primary purpose of ***Sowing Seeds of Social Beauty*** is to introduce the CHPEM and encourage, facilitate, and inform healthy, respectful, widespread public dialogue that focuses on the foundational social understandings of the CHPEM versus the foundational social (mis)understandings of corporate capitalism (capitalism's Achilles' heel). After extensive public dialogue has occurred, the public could democratically decide whether to accept and continue the Mean Arrangements of Man and Social Atrocities that are predictably generated by global corporate capitalism, or gently and peacefully transition to an economic model that generates Kind Social Arrangements and Social Beauty.

Note to Reader:

The quickest way to determine the main messages of ***Sowing Seeds of Social Beauty*** is to read the Preface, peruse the Table of Contents, read Chapter 4 (which is written in the form of a play and introduces the concepts discussed in the rest of the manuscript), and read Chapters 12, 13, and 14. The rest of the manuscript further explains those messages and addresses specific fears and concerns that readers may have about applying the CHPEM to a general economy.
